Emotions Memory Game



Purpose

Teach the child to recognize emotions, talk about them and make the connection with the name of the emotion.

Required material

Sheet with smiley faces and list of emotions.


Step-by-step activity:

- 1. Print the attached sheets on card stock.
- 2. Cut all the face designs and the words corresponding to each emotion.
- 3. Turn all the drawings and written words upside down and shuffle them.
- **4.** Begin the game by starting with the youngest child. He or she must flip around a face card and a word card to find the matching pair.
- 5. Each time a player pairs up, he must remember a situation in which he felt that emotion and share with the group. Once they are done, the cards remain theirs.
- 6. Each player must follow their turn to flip around the cards until all pairs are found.
- 7. The one with the most cards wins.

NOTE: It is also an excellent opportunity for adults to recognize, validate their feelings and show that everyone - regardless of age - feels these emotions.
