## Identifying emotions in other people



#### Purpose

Develop empathy by identifying emotions that other people are feeling just by looking at them.

### Required material

Attached sheet, magazines, scissors and glue.

### Step-by-step activity:

- 1. Print the attached sheet.
- 2. Show the reserved space (geometric figures) for each of the emotions on paper. The child should look into magazines for an image that represents each emotion (an adult, a child or even an animal expressing this same feeling). For example, to paste in the star picture that says "happy" he or she should look for a picture where the character is smiling.
- 3. Ask them to cut and paste at the indicated location.
- 4. Ask which picture was easier to find and which was harder.
- 5. Discuss the importance of recognizing the emotion in other people for a healthy relationship.

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
